Glenn is a retired aesthetic and reconstructive plastic surgeon in Raleigh, NC. He has served as an Adjunct Clinical Professor of Surgery at the University of North Carolina School of Medicine, president of the NC Society of Plastic Surgeons, president of the Raleigh Academy of Medicine, and Chair of the Council of State and Regional Plastic Surgery Societies. He has served on the Board of Directors and as Historian of the American Society of Plastic Surgery. Additional service has been as Vice President of the local Boy Scouts Council, Vice President of Filling in the Gaps Charity of Wake County and Shop Crew for Habitat for Humanity of Wake County.

As an Army Brat growing up all over the country, Glenn attended four different high schools but did not manage to graduate from any of them. After a bachelor's degree in mathematics from the University of the South, Sewanee, TN, he received his MD from the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston. Naval service followed with two years as a flight surgeon and then five years as a general surgical resident at the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda. Plastic surgery residency followed and two years as Assistant Chief of Plastic Surgery at Bethesda Naval Hospital. Continuing as a reserve officer, he served as commanding officer of a naval reserve hospital unit for Naval Hospital Charleston and retired as a captain.
