The Rev. David M. Goldberg, OStJ, is the Associate Rector at St. Mark's Episcopal Church and School in Houston, Texas. He joined St. Mark's in 2020, after serving as a curate at Iglesia Episcopal San Pedro in Pasadena, Texas, a Spanish-speaking mission of the Episcopal Diocese of Texas. David's deep connection with the Church began with his passion for acolyting and his family's active participation in their home parish in Westport, Connecticut. Post-high school, he read theology at the University of Oxford, earning a BA in 2012. He then completed an MA at the University of London's School of Oriental and African Studies in 2013. Before joining the seminary, he worked as a policy aide for the Houston City Council for a year. In 2018, he graduated from the Virginia Theological Seminary.

Since 2019, David has served as the co-chair of the Houston Region of the Order of St John. He was also the co-chair of the 2022 Investiture Gala. In 2022, he was appointed co-convener of the Council of Regional Chairs. His commitment to St. John International is driven by its mission to serve the sick and the poor, honoring its heritage and history.

David is also deeply interested in early modern British history. He is currently pursuing his doctorate at the University of Oxford, focusing on royalism during the 1640s and 1650s.
